The Seaside

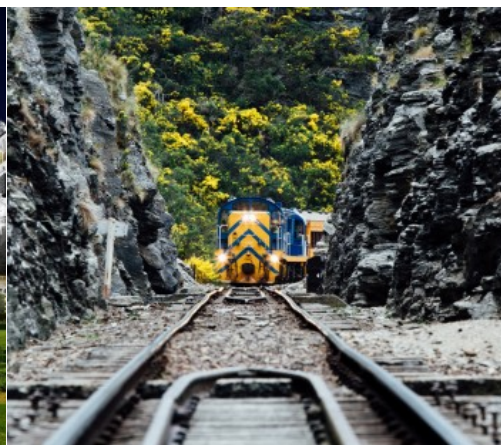
